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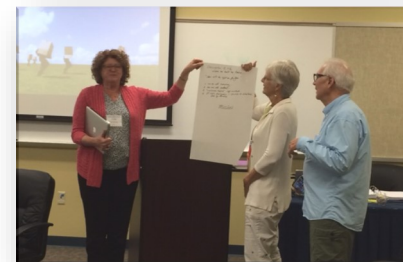

Fundamentals of Transitional Ministry

Two courses, *The Work of the Leader* and *The Work of the Congregation*, cover foundational elements and build skills to effectively guide congregations in times of change. Fieldwork puts the concepts into practice.
